TEMPERATURE

Less than 37.5°C

REQUIRED ACTION

Student advised to proceed to class.

Equal to or greater than 37.5°C on first reading The student should be asked to wait in a separate room and have their temperature re-checked in 15 minutes.

If the student is wearing outerwear, the staff member should suggest the child remove this once they are indoors.

Equal to or greater than 37.5°C on second reading The student should return home with their parent/carer.

If parent/carer is not present, the student will need to be isolated and the parent/carer contacted to collect them from school as soon as possible.

Families should be encouraged to seek the advice of their healthcare professional who can advise on next steps and coronavirus (COVID-19) testing.








This week students in Group P7 visited the Warrnambool CBD where they had a look at all the amazing street art that is being displayed there.
