S2 received the Food For Life award for working cooperatively in the kitchen with mutual respect.

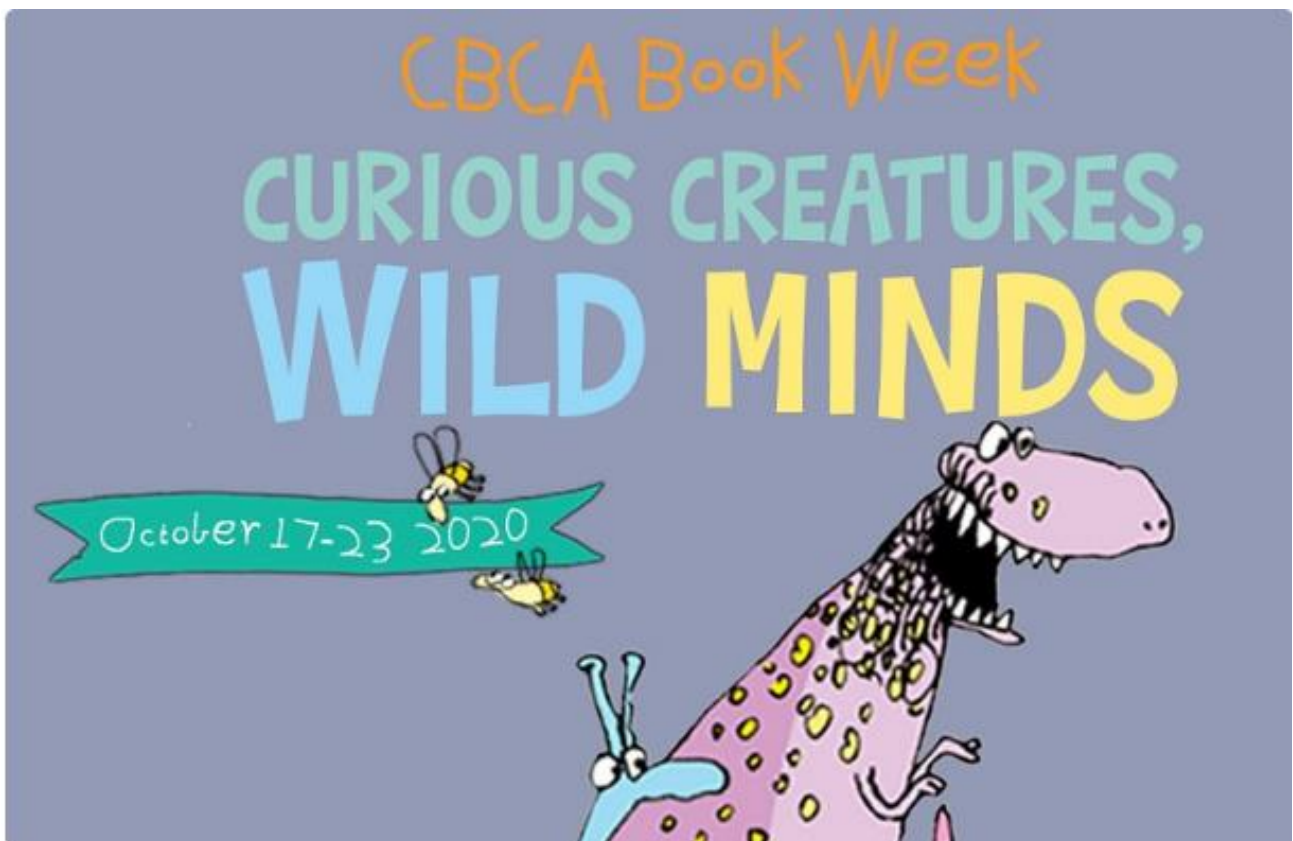
BOOK WEEK
